Adrian Daintrey was born in 1902 and studied at the Slade School. His career owes much to the encouragement of his old friends, the late Augustus John and Sir Matthew Smith. After his studies he lived in Paris for some years and regularly returns to the city which he has painted and recorded throughout his life. He has always been a great traveller and has described his experiences in his autobiography "*I Must Say*". This exhibition includes impressions of places as diverse as Delhi, Corfu, Ischia, Bangkok, Istanbul, Singapore and Rome – quite apart from street scenes in "Little Venice" and Maida Vale where he lives, and Paris.

His commissions include London scenes for the Ministry of Works, for British Embassies abroad; for the Duke of Devonshire he has done drawings of Pratt's Club; views of their offices for S.H.Benson; a B.E.A. poster for Coleman, Prentice and Varley; and wall decorations for the home of Sir Robert and Lady Adeane. He was asked to make a drawing of Government House, Ottawa for the then Governor-General Mr Vincent Massey and subsequently received several other commissions in Ottawa and later in Bermuda and the United States.

Lord Kinross has described Adrian Daintrey as "A civilised, urbane cosmopolitan artist, an English draughtsman abroad and the European draughtsman at home. In his insistence on elegance, not in the sense of ephemeral fashion and chic but in that of enduring grace and style, he is an artist who communicates civilised pleasure".
