

The works in this exhibition, with one exception, are drawn from the last fifteen years of the painter's output. However, even at the end of a long creative life the vision is undimmed.

The themes of Chagall's work range from the most humble and intimate to the great traditional subjects drawn from the Bible and from mythology. The villages depicted have their roots in the Russian Jewish environment of Chagall's youth where the cycle of peasant life is attended by festivity. Benevolent larger—than—life domestic animals seize musical instruments and in the examples shown here a warm glow suffuses the scene.


Lovers and married life are celebrated throughout Chagall's life. The ecstatic couples float in an atmosphere charged with brilliant colours, calmly contemplating flowers, birds and moons which are for Chagall the symbols of harmony.

If the lovers defy gravity so too do the acrobats and equestriennes of the circus. Here Chagall can abandon perspective and place these figures in a whirl of activity midway between the real and the fantastic.

The great stained glass programmes, for instance The Jerusalem Windows, and the series of etchings illustrating the Bible, published by Tériade in 1956, are widely known examples of Chagall's treatment of religious themes. This preoccupation is represented in this exhibition by two monumental images of Moses.

Throughout his life Chagall was aware of his position as an artist. Early self-portraits make this self-consciousness quite clear and in his maturity it is still to the fore: the atelier is recorded in surprisingly literal detail in No.8, the artist is at work in No.3, and in No.10, the striking "le Visage Jaune", the palette and the brushes occupy the foreground.


1. LE CLOWN AU CIRQUE










7. MOÏSE ET LES TABLES LOI Stamped with signature "Marc Chagall" Tempera on board 35 x 27cm 1982




DANS L'ATELIER




