Introduction

Kerry Hallam was born and brought up in the north of England. At the age of 18 he won a six-year scholarship to London University. He then undertook military service in Hong Kong and Malaya before becoming a commercial illustrator in London in 1961. Three years later Hallam determined that he would expand his art and 'One day, I finally packed up everything into a little truck and drove to the south of France'.

In Ramatuelle close to St. Tropez, he discovered the light he had only read about and his painting flourished. He admits a strong affinity for the 19th century French Impressionists and even today, 30 years later, Hallam's paintings pay homage to these years spent developing his craft, painting seascapes and timeless sun-dappled village scenes.

In 1973 Hallam settled in New England and since 1980 has based himself on Nantucket Island which has become his second spiritual home and provides the inspiration for his work although he frequently visits France to paint.

Hallam has exhibited at ArtExpo in New York every year since 1988. In recent years he has had several successful exhibitons in the States and Japan but this will be his first one-man show in the UK. Each year he spends time in the South of France to renew his energies.








Eiffel Collage collage on canvas 91.5 x 61cm




2 Riviera Terrace acrylic on canvas 76 x 91.5cm




Riviera Vista 3 acrylic on canvas 30.5 x 61cm




St. Tropez acrylic on canvas 76 x 91.5cm




Le Cabenon acrylic on canvas 30.5 x 61cm



6 Tower Bridge acrylic on canvas 61 x 91.5cm








