SIMONIDES (556-468 BC)

Looking at a subject over a long period of time reveals subtleties that can be missed by a casual glance. Time can reveal the unique within the ordinary: the mystery of the commonplace. Specific knowledge informs the work, directly and indirectly.

This exhibition is a collection of carefully wrought images: Portraits, Interiors, Still Lifes. Each of the works is informed by considered draughtsmanship and close attention to detail, colour and texture. But they are more than an accurate record of the visual world. They are imbued with an enduring quality, a stillness which transmutes the images into objects of contemplation and emotional evocation. Each picture becomes its own small world.

Individual 'small worlds' take shape slowly and illuminate ephemeral associations: cutlery, an old tin jug, a bowl, a ball of string, shoes... Each work acquires a personality of its own, an independent reality. In time, an intimate relationship between the image and the artist is formed. The viewer senses this rapport and becomes part of it. Unassuming, unemphatic and everyday things reveal personal resonances and take on significance as the image evolves. Quietly attempting to create something that cannot adequately be said.




1. PORTRAIT OF AMANDA, 1994




2. PORTRAIT OF SLÂN HUGHES, 1987








